



ISAIAH HOUSE OUTREACH

Isaiah House is a community of believers that join together the last Saturday of each month, rain or shine, at St. Elizabeth Medical Center parking lot in Covington and Ludlow Vets parking lot in Ludlow, Kentucky to share hope, love, and fresh food with individuals and families in need. We are members of local churches coming together to be The Church in our community. Isaiah House partners with MASTER PROVISIONS Food Outreach Program to obtain and transport produce, bread, and drinks that are distributed at the outreach.

The monthly outreach events are all-volunteer, all-donation, self-contained outdoor events. All items associated with the events are brought in early on Saturday morning and are removed at the end of the event. The distribution begins at 9:30 am and ends before noon.



Volunteers assist prior to the event with packing/loading of food at the Master Provisions warehouse. At the outreach events volunteers set-up/break-down, hand out groceries, carry groceries for guests, direct parking, clean up trash in and around the event, prepare and serve lunch, and perform administrative tasks. A

Gospel message is shared and volunteers encourage and pray with the guests waiting in line for food. The Outreach events serve between 500 and 700 families and more than 200 volunteers are onsite in Ludlow and Covington to help each month.

How to Get Involved:

1) Before the outreach events

On the last Thursday and Friday of each month volunteers help sort, pack, and load groceries/produce for the outreach events. We do the food pack at Master Provisions Warehouse at 7725 Foundation Drive in Florence, KY between 9 am and 5 pm. Just show up at the warehouse and we will put you to work. Even 1 hour of your time is valuable.

2) At the outreach events

On the last Saturday of each month we distribute the groceries to anyone in need at Ludlow Vets (830 Elm St Ludlow 41016) or St. Elizabeth Covington parking lots (1500 James Simpson Covington 41011). Volunteers check-in between 8 am & 8:30 am and are assigned a serving role. The events usually end by noon.
